NOTES FOR EACH SEMESTER

Before & During 8112

- Contact the potential Faculty Chair to discuss possible project. A list of current faculty chairs is available on the DMin Student Resources page of CampusNet in a document called “Faculty Chair Help.”
- Secure a Faculty Chair
- Submit the [Faculty Chair Request Approval Form](#). You will receive an email confirming approval from the DMin Office.
- Work on preparing the PPO and begin meeting regularly with your Faculty Chair to discuss the project.

During 8141

- Continue working with your Faculty Chair on the project idea, MPP, and project questions by meeting monthly.
- Complete the Ministry Project Proposal (MPP).
- Make contacts with Faculty Chair during 8141 to discuss and approve your Ministry Project Proposal (MPP).
- Prepare the Research Ethics Approval Form, available on the DMin Student Resources page of CampusNet.
- Once all coursework (all workshops, seminars, and CLE’s) are complete, submit the Candidacy Approval form, along with your Research Ethics Approval Form and MPP to the DMin Office.

During 8151

- Make monthly contacts with Faculty Chair to discuss the Ministry Project. You have the responsibility to make the contact. Remember, your chair will be grading you on your progress, so you must stay in contact.
- Chapters 1 – 3 must be submitted to the DMin office for proofreading in order to receive a passing grade for this course. DMN8151 will be repeated until Chapters 1 – 3 are complete.

During 8152

- Make monthly contacts with Faculty Chair to discuss the Ministry Project. You have the responsibility to make the contact. Remember, your chair will be grading you on your progress, so you must stay in contact.
- Chapters 4 – 5 must be submitted to the DMin office for proofing in order to receive a passing grade for this course. DMN8152 will be repeated until graduation.
